#### Mangaweka Plunket Home Help Service



Mangaweka, Ohingaiti & Rangiwhia sub branch of Plunket offer 5 hours of home help to **ALL** families living within the sub branch area at the time of the birth of the baby. Ideally these hours are offered to help support families with a newborn baby, however, they can also be used at any time until the your child turns 5 years of age.

#### 10 Hours Home Help for Caesarean Births

Mangaweka, Ohingaiti & Rangiwhia sub branch of Plunket offer 10 hours of home help to all families within our sub branch area where a caesarean birth has occurred. These hours are ideally for use while Mum is recovering from her c-section. As plunket doesn't take over from the midwives until baby is a few weeks old, anyone not with the Taihape Midwives may be unaware that this service exists.
